



Turlybek Ilyasovich Mamseyit was born 17 February 1949 in the suburbs of Almaty, Raiymbek district, v. Tekes. He is writer, critic. In 1975 he graduated S. M. Kirov KazGU University, faculty of journalism. From 1975-1977, he worked in the regional newspaper "Zhetysu", national book chamber. In 1977-1995, he has been the editor of the publishing house "Zhazushy", head of the editorial Board, in 1996-1998 editor-in-chief of the publishing house "Oner", in 1998-1999 – the chief editor of the publishing house "Rauan", In 1999-2001 he worked in the Corporation "Atamura". From 2001-2008 he was the editor of the publishing house "Elorda" in Astana. The first critical articles were published in the press since 1973. He worked since 2008 as chief editor in the publishing house of JSC "Astana Polygraphy". His first published story was included in the collection of young writers "Arman kanatinda". The author of the novel "Kankuily Zharyk" and the novel "Tanzharyk", a collection of novels and short stories "Cry of the hunter", "Aulieshoky", "Betoramal", "Tusime tau kiredi", "Besik pen nesip" critical articles "Togiskan tolkyn", "Zerdelik ainasy". Some of his works translated into Kyrgyz, Turkmen, Russian and Chinese. The story "Tauda osken ul" became the winner of the closed competition organized by the publishing house "Zhalyn". He is the author of research papers "Egiz eldin aueni", "Sherkhan Murtaza". He is a Candidate of Philology. In recent years, the drama "Bukei Kyz" was performed on the stage of the M. Auezov Academic Drama Theater. In 1996, the writer won the Zhambyl International Prize in honor of the 150th anniversary of Zhambyl, and in 2000 he was awarded the International Literature Prize "Alash" for the novel "Aulieshoky". He was also awarded a medal in honor of the 10th anniversary of Astana.
